GREEN SCHOOLS FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIPS

The Green Schools Foundation annually awards scholarships to Green High School seniors who will be entering college or the skilled trades upon graduation. The Foundation awards several scholarships under the Foundation's name. Additional named scholarships awarded are the ***Neva and Barbara Brenneman Future Educator Scholarship*** for students pursuing a career in education, the ***Pollock Family Scholarship*** for students who are active in both music and sports, the ***Connie Leonard Scholarship*** for students who are active in school clubs and the Green Schools Foundation, the ***Pritchard Scholarship*** for students who will be pursuing an entrepreneurial career, the ***Loving Hands Scholarship*** for former students of their preschool, and the ***Mike Currey Scholarship*** for his former students.

The ***Cuthbert Family Trades Scholarship*** and the ***Mark S. Hoppe Trades Scholarship*** are for students who will be entering the skilled trades. Students may apply for these scholarships by using the School to Work scholarship application.
